What is the difference between the internet, browsers, search engines and websites?

- A web browser takes you anywhere on the internet, letting you see text, images and video from anywhere in the world.
 - <u>The browser</u> is the car that gets you everywhere. You type a destination into the address bar and zoooom: your browser takes you anywhere on the internet.
- A web browser (commonly referred to as a browser) is <u>application software</u> for accessing the <u>World Wide</u>
 Web.
- A web browser is not the same thing as a <u>search engine</u>, though the two are often confused.
- Web browsers are used on a range of devices, including <u>desktops</u>, <u>laptops</u>, <u>tablets</u>, and <u>smartphones</u>.
 - In 2020, an estimated 4.9 billion people used a browser.
 - The most used browser is Google Chrome, with a 65% global market share on all devices, followed by Safari with 18%.

What is Search Engine?

- Search engines like Yahoo, Google, Bing and DuckDuckGo etc. are the compass and the map. You tell a search engine an idea of where you want to go by typing your search terms, and it gives you some possible destinations.
- A search engine is a software system that is designed to carry out web searches.
 - They search the World Wide Web in a systematic way for particular information specified in a textual web search query.
 - The search results are generally presented in a line of results, often referred to as search engine <u>results pages.</u>

Web Sites and the Web!

- Effectively, you drive along the internet highway, stopping at whatever towns, stores and roadside attractions catch your fancy, aka websites.
- Websites are the specific destinations you visit throughout the internet.
 - This is the content the webpages, websites, documents, social media, news, videos, images and so on that you view and experience via the internet.
 - The "web" (which is short for "world wide web", hence "www") is the collection of all these websites.

- In June of 2021Google announced that it would ban cross-site cookie tracking, it implemented its own tracker called the Federated Learning of Cohorts, or FLoC. This software runs in your browser's background and groups you with people who it thinks share your interests. This opened up other security holes like Zero Day.

Brave

Brave (Brave Software)



- Best for those who are interested in fast and secure browsing while earning at the same time.
- Browse 3 times faster than chrome. (Benchmark tests)
- Brave is a free web browser that blocks ads and website trackers.
- It works on Windows, Mac OS, Linux, Android, and iOS.
- Allows websites and content writers a way to earn micropayments in the form of BATs (Basic Attention Tokens), which is an open-source.
- Decentralized ad exchange platform, based on <u>Etherium</u>.

Brave (Brave Software)



Disadvantages of Brave browser:

Probably the biggest downside to Brave is its current **lack of extensions**, **add-ons**, **and plug-ins**. While browsers like Firefox, Chrome, Opera, etc. seem to have extensions for almost everything under the sun, Brave's library is basically limited to password managers, like <u>Dashlane</u> and <u>LastPass</u>, and a handful of other extensions.

Verdict: A February 2020 research report published by the School of Computer Science and Statistics at Trinity College Dublin tested a number of browsers and found Brave to be the most private of them.

In the first most private group lies Brave, in the second place are Chrome, Firefox, and Safari, and in the third place (least private group) lies Edge and Yandex.

Moreover, Brave allows you to earn rewards in the form of BATs and have fast and safe browsing. Such unique features are enough to make it one of the top 10 browsers.

Vivaldi

Vivaldi (Vivaldi Technologies)



- Best for people who work on a number of tabs at the same time.
- Vivaldi is a PC Browser with some unique features and gives a fast and secure browsing experience to its users by <u>blocking the ads and trackers</u>.
- Available for Android, Mac, Linux, and Windows. It supports 53 languages.
- Freeware, cross-platform web browser

- Groups tabs in a stack.
- A built-in ad and tracker blocker.
- Custom keyboard shortcuts for everything.
- Add any website as a web panel.
- Multiple colored themes to pick from.

Vivaldi (Vivaldi Technologies)



Disadvantages of Vivaldi browser:

- Might Not Appeal to Most Web Browser Users
- Not the Fastest Chromium Browser in the Market
- Tendency to Consume Too many System Resources
- However, a considerable drawback of Vivaldi is that <u>it is not for everyone</u>. As a one-stop
 application loaded with numerous features and tools, some users might find it too much,
 especially those individuals who prefer using a simple browser primarily meant for opening
 and browsing through websites and web pages.

Verdict: Vivaldi has a positive aspect that it is light on RAM consumption when compared to
other browsers. Thus, it can prove to be the best browser that falls short of RAM.

DuckDuckGo

DuckDuckGo (DuckDuckGo was founded by Gabriel Weinberg)



Best for those who do not want to compromise with privacy.

- DuckDuckGo web browser, <u>claims that they never collect or store the user's personal</u> information ever.
- It has some very cool features to attract users and has an outstanding rating of 4.4/5.

Disadvantages:

- •DuckDuckGo DuckDuckGo still relies on advertising to make money, so you'll see advertisements in your searches.
- The distinction is that the advertisements aren't tailored to each particular user.
- DuckDuckGo does not include any anti-virus, anti-malware, anti-ransomware, or anti-malware protection.

Chromium

Chromium (Free open-source Maintained by Google)



Best for people who look for an alternative to Chrome. It is light-weight and gives fast browsing experience.

- Chromium is an open-source Google-sponsored browser project that aims to provide a faster, safer, and more stable way for all users to experience the web.
- This web browser <u>has fewer features</u> than Google Chrome due to the reason that it is being built to be light-weight (cognitively and physically) and fast.

- Auto-update capability
- •API keys for some google services.
- •Sync between devices.
- •Does not collect any of your information and deliver it to Google.
- •Features that are later updated on Chrome can be experienced earlier on Chromium.

Chromium

Chromium (Free open-source Mainained by Google)



- Disadvantages:
 - Chromium browser eats a lot of RAM such as Chrome,
 - This makes a problem for machines with less RAM.
 - Does not support certain common media formats and some codecs such as AAC, H.264, MP3.
- **Verdict:** As a web browser, Chromium is less stable than Chrome i.e. it crashes more often.
 - Can exhibit other types of undesirable behavior at times. But it is the best browser to have a simple, and easy-to-go browsing experience.

Epic (Hidden Reflex - 2019)



Best for people who want utmost privacy from hidden information trackers.

- Epic is a free browser where you can enjoy anonymously with private surfing.
- Blocks unauthorized websites from tracking your data.
- Proves to be one of the best browsers for people having privacy and securityrelated concerns.

- Acts as a blocker for privacy leaks.
- Comes with VPN servers.
- Constantly works in the incognito mode.
- Clip content
- •Maintain backups of certain data.

Epic (Hidden Reflex - 2019)



Disadvantages:

Epic can be difficult to navigate as a beginner because there are so many features.
 It is best to learn the basics before trying to use the advanced tools.

Verdict: Users have been complaining that some websites don't work well with the Epic browser, and this proves to be a huge setback, but it is a great platform for people who are concerned more about privacy.
