What is Streaming?

It's a method of transmitting or receiving data (video and audio) over a network with STEADY, Continuous Flow, allowing playback to start while the rest of the data is still being received.

History

Late 1990's to early 2000

- Technology advancements in Networks increased speed and reliability
- The first streaming product was StarWork by Microsoft using a proprietary format MPEG-1
- Mircosoft created ActiveMovie in 1995 The Precursor to Windows Media Player
- Apple Inc introduced QuickTime in 1995
